

The Partners hope that this Newsletter will be of benefit to their Patients and will open up an additional line of communication between you and them.

ELECTRONIC PRESCRIPTIONS—A BRIEF OUTLINE

The Surgery is now able to send your requested prescriptions electronically to your chosen Chemist.

How it works:

- 1. You/the chemist puts in the request as usual to the Surgery;
- 2. The surgery draws up the prescription on screen and forwards it to the GP;
- 3. The GP authorises/signs the prescription electronically;
- 4. The prescription is sent electronically to the chosen Chemist.

Once the GP has electronically signed the prescription the Chemist should receive it within 30 minutes.

The Surgery is still requesting you allow 48 working hours for the prescription to be actioned.

This is another step nearer the Surgery's goal to become a paperless Surgery.
