Pre Bookable Appointments

You can book these 4 weeks in advance for GPs, baby clinic and our Phlebotomy Clinic. Baby clinic appointments are held on a Tuesday and Friday. You can book appointments 8 weeks in advance with our Nurses.

On the Day Appointments

These appointments get released at 8am each morning for am appointments and 12.30 PM for afternoon appointments with GPs.

Emergencies

Every day we have a Duty Doctor that deals with medical emergencies. Emergency appointments cannot be booked for Prescription updates or Medication certificates. Afternoon appointments get released at 12.30pm

Prescriptions

Prescriptions take 72 hours (3days to process). We do not take prescription requests over the phone. However you can contact your local pharmacy and ask them to put the request in on your behalf.
